Honors Seminars

Honor students are invited to participate in honors seminars. The seminars are interdisciplinary and are taught by faculty from a variety of disciplines. The specific structure of each seminar varies regarding meeting time, length of seminars, and number of class sessions. Successful completion of two honors seminars enables the student to fulfill part of the requirements for graduating in the honors program (see: Honors Program (http://catalog.mtmercy.edu/archives/2013-14/ academicpolicyinformation/#honorsprogramtext)). Honors seminars do not count toward major, minor, or core curriculum credit.

Prerequisites for enrollment in any Honors Seminar:

- 1. The student must have at least sophomore standing (completed at least 30 credit hours), and
- 2. The student must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.00.
